Dialling 999 Script

You must only do this in an emergency. People's lives are at risk if an ambulance does not get to them because of a hoax call.

Caller: Dial 999 (Try to keep calm and speak clearly)

Operator: Which service do you need: police, fire or ambulance?

Caller: Answer (You must tell them clearly which one you need)

Operator: What is your name and address?

Caller: Answer (Give your own name and address)

Operator: Where are you now?

Caller: Answer (Give the address of where you are. If you do

not know the address, look around you and see if there

is a street name or a building with a name on it)

Operator: What is the problem? Tell me exactly what has

happened.

Caller: Answer (Tell the operator about who is sick or hurt and

what happened to them).

Operator: Is the person conscious?

Caller: Answer (This means is the person awake, answer yes

or no).

Operator: Is the person breathing?

Caller: Answer (You can tell if they are breathing by putting

your hand on their chest near their heart and see if it

goes up and down. Answer yes or no).

Operator: Please stay on the line until the ambulance arrives. If

anything changes let me know.

Caller: Stay on the telephone and watch the person who is ill

for any changes.
