End of Summer Term and September Arrangements

End of Summer Term

School will close for the summer break on Friday 12th July, with students being dismissed at 12.01pm. This is as advised in my letter to you dated the 28th of March 2024

Any student in receipt of free school meals will be able to collect a packed lunch from the canteen during break time should they wish to do so.

Return to School in September 2024


- Monday 2nd September: Staff training day. Students are not expected in school.
- Tuesday 3rd September:
 - Year 7 students are expected onsite between 8.30 am- 3.15pm, including a lunch break between 1.25-2.15. Students will get their timetables and then be in their timetabled lessons from 11.15 onwards.
 - Year 12 students are expected onsite between 9.30am-3.15pm, including a lunch break between 1.25-2.15. Students will get their timetables and then be in their timetabled lessons from 11.15 onwards.
 - All other year groups should not attend school.
- Wednesday 4th September:
 - All year groups are expected in school at the start time of 8.30am.
 - All students will have an extended form time from 8.30-9.55, and then will go to their timetabled lessons.
 - Students will finish at the normal time on a Wednesday which is 2.10pm.
