### Year 11, 12 and 13 Easter Forum Revision

In order to support students in the last few weeks of their formal exams, we will be running revision sessions during the Easter holidays.

Revision classes will be run from **Tuesday 2nd – Friday 12th April**. These revision classes give an opportunity for your son/daughter to take part in a structured programme that will help them to focus their revision. Students may wear their own clothes, but, as with Tag Days, we ask that they dress sensibly: no shoulders or midriffs exposed.

The programme overleaf shows the classes that are on offer for particular students in Years 11-13. Morning sessions run from 10am-12pm, and afternoon sessions from 1pm-3pm. Students should only be onsite for the sessions which they are required to attend. Any poor behaviour will mean a student will be asked to leave by a member of staff.

Students are expected to arrive on time and to stay for the whole session. If they have a morning and afternoon session on the same day, they can remain onsite throughout, with a 60-minute lunch break for refreshments. A packed lunch will be required as the kitchens will not be open. Students should bring food and drinks (not fizzy) for this purpose, as they are NOT permitted to go off site during the revision sessions. Students will be expected to sign in at reception.
