Dear Parent(s) and Carer(s),

End of Summer Term and September Arrangements

I am writing to share our arrangements for the end of this term and the start of the next. As you are aware, we anticipate moving into our new single-site build on City Way in the forthcoming academic year and so this has required us to make some changes to our calendar.

School will close to students for the summer break on Friday 15th July. This is to allow staff two days the following week to declutter and remove rubbish from classrooms to make the eventual process of packing and moving easier. Please note the following arrangements for 15th July:

- Students will be dismissed at 12.01pm.
- The last day of term is a tag day to raise money for those affected by the conflict in Ukraine. Students are asked to pay £1 to take part. We would request that all tops have a modest neckline, that there are no exposed midriffs and that any shorts / skirts worn are no shorter than two inches above the knee.
- Any student in receipt of free school meals will be able to collect a packed lunch from the canteen during break time, should they wish to do so.

School will begin at the start of September. This is earlier than some other schools so that we can ensure that we can make up for any teaching time lost during our moving days to City Way. Please note the following return arrangements for different year groups as below:

- **Year 7 start on Friday 2nd September** on our Maidstone Road site and are expected to attend between 10am-3.05pm.
- **Year 12 start on Friday 2nd September** on our Maidstone Road site and are expected to attend between 10.40am and 1.30pm.
- **All other students in Years 8-11 (Ordnance Street site) and Year 13 (Maidstone Road site) will resume school on Monday 5th September.** All students will be expected in school for the normal start time of 8.35am and will finish at the normal time of 3.05pm.
